## Functional Literacy Enhancement Project Report

**Project Title:** Functional Literacy Enhancement Program

**Location:** Takuda and Basyaltol, Sandhikharka Municipality–12, Arghakhanchi District, Nepal

### Background

Rotary Club of Butwal Downtown launched a 20-day Functional Literacy Program in Takuda and Basyaltol of Sandhikharka Municipality–12, Arghakhanchi. The project aims to improve the literacy level of illiterate and semi-literate community members and empower them with practical life skills required for daily living.

### Objectives

- Develop basic reading, writing, and numeracy skills among participants.
- Enhance confidence and independence in daily activities.
- Improve understanding of simple banking transactions and financial record keeping.
- Enable participants to use mobile phones for communication and essential services.
- Promote lifelong learning and community participation.

### Project Implementation

The program is being conducted over a period of 20 days through interactive learning sessions. Participants receive practical training in functional literacy, basic mathematics, and everyday life skills that can be directly applied in their homes and communities.

### Inauguration and Participation

The program was inaugurated in the presence of Mr. Narayan Khadka, Ward Chairperson of Sandhikharka Municipality–12; community leaders Mr. Baburam Basyal, Mr. Raju Mukhiya, and Mr. Sunil Giri; Rotary Club of Butwal Downtown Past Presidents Rtn. ### Training Team

The literacy sessions are facilitated by Ms. Sharda Belbase and Ms. Sapana Bhusal. They provide training on functional literacy, basic mathematics, and practical skills useful in everyday life.

### Beneficiaries

Approximately 40 local women and senior citizens are participating in the program. The project focuses on improving their literacy, confidence, and ability to engage more effectively in social and economic activities.

### Expected Outcomes

Upon completion of the program, participants are expected to acquire basic literacy and numeracy skills, gain confidence in handling daily tasks, understand simple financial transactions, and use mobile communication tools effectively. The project contributes to Rotary's commitment to community development, education, and empowerment.
